- Read Luke 18:1-8. What are the similarities and differences between this parable and the one in Luke 11:5-8?
- Why does Jesus value persistent and repetitive prayer?
- Why are we tempted to stop praying for the same request over and over?
- What can help you be more persistent in your prayers?
- Why is it important in our prayers to declare God's greatness and our neediness?
- What is one thing that you should be boldly banging on the door of heaven for? What in your life is worth consistently praying for?
