Discussion Questions

- Growing up, what was Easter like for you?
- What did God teach you through the sermon this weekend?
- Read Acts 2:22-39, where Peter delivers a speech about why Jesus is who He claimed to be: The Son of God.
 - What stands out to you about this passage?
 - What proofs do you see here that Jesus is the Son of God?
 - How does the disciples' behavior (like we see here in Peter) after the resurrection lend credibility to the claims of Christianity?
 - What emotions must the hearers have been feeling?
 - How did the hearers of Peter's message respond? How do you respond? What does his message do for your faith?
- How central is the resurrection to the validity of the Christian message?
- How does the certainty of Jesus' resurrection impact you today?
- In 1 Peter 2:24 Peter says: "He himself bore our sins in his body on the cross", Peter believed that Jesus' death and resurrection paid for your sin. What made Him believe this? Do you believe it?
