 - What truths or Bible verses do you turn to again and again for encouragement?
- Read Ephesians 2:17-22; I Peter 2:4-10; Ephesians 4:1-16; and Hebrews 10:24-25.
 - What stands out to you from these passages about the church?
 - What metaphor speaks to you most about the church? Why?
 - Why is the local church important for your spiritual growth? What do we miss out on without it?
- What does Carlos' quotes mean to you "Church is not a place you go to, it is a people that we go with" and "The Church today is a taste of Heaven"? What does each quote tell us about the nature, value, and function of the local church?
- What would it mean for you to re-up your commitment to go "with" the church? Where in the church do you plan to invest your time?
